He will lecture on *Cooperation in Networks*, on 16 & 17 December 2020 from 7.30 PM IST.

Professor Jonathan Morduch: The past and future of Microcredit

Prof. Jonathan Morduch, Professor of Public Policy and Economics at the Robert F. Wagner Graduate School of Public Service, University of New York. He is a development economist most well-known for his significant academic contributions to assessing the impact of microfinance since the early years of the movement. Prof. Morduch has taught on the Economics faculty at Harvard University, and has held visiting positions at Stanford, Princeton, Hitotsubashi University, and the University of Tokyo. Morduch has worked with the United Nations and World Bank, and advises global NGOs. He will lecture on *The past and future of Microcredit*, on 8 January 2021 from 7.30 PM IST.
