General Rules & Regulations

Extempore

Eligibility:

1. The extempore competition is open to all UG, PG, Scholars, Alumni and Faculties of any educational institutes of West Bengal.
2. Participants must enroll themselves through the following registration portal. <https://qrco.de/be1f3N>
3. Each participant will be given a time limit of 5mins to speak on the given topic.
4. Participants will choose their topics through random selection of themes through chits, provided during the event.
5. The topics will be related to the ocean, marine life, conservation, environmental issues, or any other relevant subject.
6. Participants have to deliver their speech exclusively in English. No other language shall be entertained.
7. Participants will be given a brief period to prepare their thoughts on the topic before they speak.

Speaking Guidelines:

- a) Participants must deliver their extempore speech in a clear and audible manner.
- b) The speech should be original and not plagiarized from any source.
- c) Participants should avoid using offensive or derogatory language during their speech.
- d) Organization committee has full right to cancel the participation of any team for adoption of unfair means.

 3. Hard copy of the poster/science toons should be submitted to marine ecology lab by hand.

Photography

Photography themes:

- a) Ocean: Live and Livelihoods
- b) Plastic pollution: Threats to the ocean
- c) Explore the beauty of marine biodiversity

*The photographs should depict one of the above-mentioned themes.

1. The competition is open to all UG, PG, Scholars, Alumni and Faculties of any educational institutes of West Bengal.
2. Only one entry allowed per participants.
3. Only digital photographs will be accepted. Participants should submit high-resolution images in JPEG or PNG format to mail id: aquaphilemel@gmail.com.
4. Participants must bring print (preferably 5" X 7") of their submitted entry on the day of exhibitions
5. All photographs must be original and taken by the participant.
6. Minor digital adjustments such as cropping, brightness/contrast adjustments, and color correction is allowed. However, heavy manipulation, compositing, or adding/removing significant elements is not permitted.
7. Watermarks or any other identifying marks should not be present on the submitted photographs.
8. Participants must provide a brief caption for each photograph and also mention the theme of the photograph.
9. A panel of photography experts and leading faculties will be responsible for evaluating the submissions and selecting the winners. Their decisions will be final.
10. Any form of plagiarism, offensive or inappropriate content, or unethical practices will result in disqualification.
